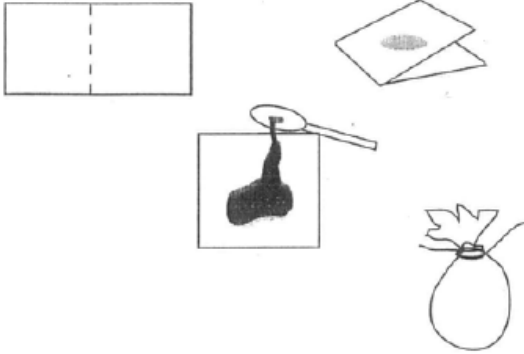
What to Bring:

FLOUR BALL INSTRUCTIONS

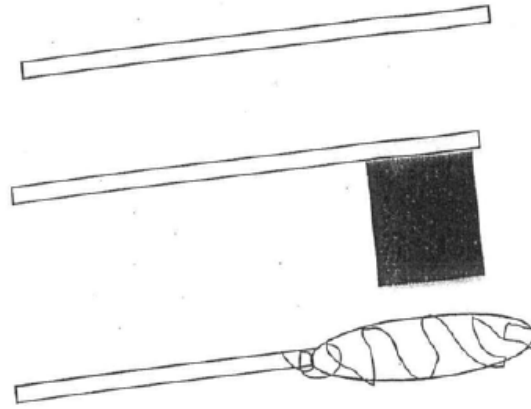
1. Using two squares of toilet tissue, fold to size of one.
2. Place one tablespoon of flour in the center of the square
3. Lift four corners and tie a string or thread around the four corners to form a ball

Note: Suggest nine balls for each Princess and three for each Guide (Big Brave).



TORCH INSTRUCTIONS

1. Take a pole 3' to 4' long.
2. Wrap one end with a rag.
3. Tie the rag onto the pole securely by wrapping it around the pole several times.
4. Fuel for the torch will be provided at the Campout.



Directions: State Route 48 South to Lebanon • Left on 123 East, approx. 3 miles Just after crossing I-71, turn left on Route 350 • Go about 2 miles to the Camp Kern entrance on the right at an S-curve.
